Training content and format is tailored to meet the needs of participants.

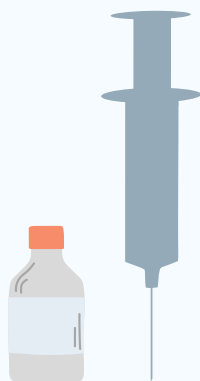
This training can be facilitated in-person or virtually.
